20 August	Houghton Hall	5 ½ miles	2 ½ hours	Moderate
24 September	Long Lane/Hickford Hill	5 miles	2 hours	Moderate
22 October	Clare Circular Walk	3 miles	1 ½ hours	Moderate

*Meet at Clare Park Centre (next to Country Park car park) at 10.00 am
The car park charge is £2 for more than 1 hour. There is no charge for the Walks
Well-behaved dogs are welcome but they will need to be on a lead at all times
Children are welcome provided parents are confident they can walk the distance
Bring appropriate clothing, footwear and WATER. Individuals walk at their own risk
Each walk involves some walking on rough ground, hence Moderate classification
